mounted police style training to the general equestrian public. However, we were delighted to be asked to deliver a two-



day obstacle and sensory clinic to the actual folks

who serve and protect us out on the streets from horseback!



Back in October 2014 we were contacted by an Officer from the City of Bethlehem Police Department Mounted Patrol Unit requesting our training services as a new experience opportunity for their program. After several conversations and Police Department approvals we settled on a two-day training for their five officers. We arranged to travel to them in June 2015.

The Clinic was a huge success with all five officers gaining new experiences and confidence with their mounts while learning the appropriate approach to difficult situations. With the small group we were able to work individually and in detail on:

- Formation Riding,
- Basic & Complex Ground Obstacles,
- Through and past Obstacles,
- Drags,
- Pickups,
- Sensory Obstacles,
- Movement,
- Precision & Control,
- Advanced Level Maneuvers, and
- Partner's Competition



We had fun with things like flying a kite from horseback in an indoor arena, tossing

the pig (pigs can really fly), and picking up the life size dummy in a partner's relay. Our Gentle Dove Farm horse,




Shamrock, delighted the crew with his impressive demonstrations. Every officer worked each obstacle that had been demonstrated. Because the officers became accustomed to the



progressive maneuvers, the advanced portion with things like smoke, flares, and gunshots were bumped up a level.

Several of the officers successfully shot from horseback our revolver with  $\frac{1}{2}$  load powder that packed quite the powerful blast. These dedicated individuals were eager, enthusiastic, attentive, and receptive to learning from our instruction. It was such a pleasure to present to them the Gentle Dove Farm training strategies and
